Non-Fleet Submission Requirements from Producer

Non-fleet submissions are defined as having 10 or fewer power units with Northland, or 15 or fewer power units with Carolina Casualty.

We require the following information to provide a quotation.

1. **ACORD application** or company application*. Company applications speed the process especially if you expect to bind with us. Applications can be obtained from our web site at www.neee.com, or we can fax/e-mail them to you upon request.
2. Non-fleets with six or more power units should have three years of currently valued **loss runs**.
3. **Driver lists:** For Northland we need years of **CDL experience and Dates of Hire** for each driver. All companies require current (within 60 days) **MVR's**. If we rate a quote without MVR'S and after binding, receive MVR's with any chargeable history, we will up-rate the policy to the premium that would have been quoted had MVR's been provided before the quote. Any accident on MVR's are regarded as at fault unless a police report is provided to verify NAF, or loss runs identify an accident sufficiently to establish no payment.
4. **Vehicle lists:** We need the **radius** of operation clearly indicated on a list of scheduled vehicles. No split radius rating is possible on non-fleet accounts with fewer than 5 power units. We also need **ACV stated** amounts, (not cost new), for each unit that will have Physical Damage coverage.
5. Most recent Schedule B.
6. * New York truck accounts will require a completed Northland application in order to quote. In order to bind New York accounts, we will have to have a copy of the application reflecting coverage requested in the binder, all MVR's, and registrations for all units to be bound. The original hard copy of the application and UM selection form be received at our office within 10 days of the binder effective date.

Upon receipt of this information we will promptly prepare a quote for you and respond as quickly as possible.
